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Minutes of the 12th Annual General Meeting held at The Royal British Legion, Rodney Street, Edinburgh at 12.30 hrs on Sunday 21st November 2010.

1. Members Present:

2. Chairman's Welcome:

Frank Murray gave a warm welcome to all present 19 members and invited all members to be upstanding in a minutes silence to remember departed friends and colleagues whom we have lost from our Association and the current conflicts in Iraq and Afghanistan.

At John Cowtan's funeral the association was represented by Mt Robin Ward (Ex OC . of 300 Sqn.)

John Lonergan was also remembered by a minutes silence, at our day out at the Falkirk Wheel

He also informed that on Armed Forces Day (25/6/10) several members of The Branch attended the parade, along with members of The Lothian Branch PRA.

4. Minutes of previous A.G.M:

- (f) Branch Representative; It was proposed by Mick Walker and seconded by Andy Paterson that this position should be shared between Jim Simpson and Tom Ormiston

Jim and Tom both agreed to carry out this duty.

10. Subscriptions:

The Treasurer proposed that the Annual Subscription remain at £6.00/annum and this was seconded by John Donaldson.

Brian Earl counter proposed that the fees should be reduced to £5.00/annum.

An open vote was taken and The Treasurers proposal was passed, by majority.
