Minutes of Ordinary General Meeting held at The Royal British Legion , Rodney Street, Edinburgh , EH7 4EL at 1300hrs on Sunday 15th March 2015

- Chairmans Welcome;** Mick Walker was unable to attend so Frank Murray, at short notice, agreed to Chair the meeting. Frank welcomed all who attended and then asked us to be upstanding for a minutes silence, whilst we remembered the personnel who have given their lives whilst serving in Iraq and Afghanistan as well as our own past members.

11. **A.O.C.B.; (a) Al Milah, Aden 1965**—This is the 50th anniversary of the attack on Al Milah Camp when both SSM John F Lonergan, 300 Para Sqn. RE., and Sgt.Cyril J Atfield, Royal Army Pay Corps were killed in action. Both are buried in Maala Cemetery, Aden. General Sir Peter Wall GCB CBE ADC Gen (Retd) has arranged for wreaths to be laid on the graves of WO2 John F Lonergan and Sgt Cyril J Atfield on 12th April 2015.

Subsequently it was agreed that we, as a branch, meet up on the same date (12/4/2015) --1300Hrs at The Guards Club in Edinburgh, where we will raise a glass or two in memory of these two fine gentlemen. Dress code is optional either collar & tie or casual but smart. There will be 3 or 4 Officers in attendance.

(b) TA Centre Renaming—Dudley Olaf has been in contact with Mick Walker and has advised him that he has verbal agreement from The Chief Exec.of whoever is in charge of the barracks, that Honeypot Lane can be renamed after John Lonergan, although 3 weeks have passed and he is still awaiting written confirmation.
